

URJO KAREDA AWARD FOR THEATRE ARTISTS 25/26 - Call for Applications

About the Award:

The Urjo Kareda Award is a residency that supports the training and artistic development of a theatre artist in collaboration with Tarragon Theatre for a twelve-month period commencing in January 2026.

This \$15,000 grant is made possible by the support of the Youssef-Warren Foundation.

We encourage you to familiarize yourself with the programming, mandate, and residencies at <u>Tarragon Theatre</u> before submitting your application.

The Residency:

The successful applicant will spend the twelve-month period at Tarragon Theatre working in collaboration with one or more artists in their chosen field of interest. This placement will take place from January 2026 – January 2027.

Eligibility:

This grant is geared towards a professional theatre artist who is a Canadian citizen / a permanent resident.

*It is recommended that the applicant is a resident of the Greater Toronto Area for the duration of the proposed residency, as additional long distance travel costs cannot be covered or reimbursed

The ideal candidate could be one, some or all of the following:

- · Theatre creators/Storytellers (ie. Playwrights, Directors, Cross-disciplinary artists, Live art creators, Choreographers etc.)
- · Mid-career artists who are transitioning into a new arts discipline (ie Actor to a Director, Designer to a Technical Director)·
- · Artists interested in arts leadership pathways (ie. Artistic Direction, Production, Management.)
- * It is asked that applicants have created or participated in at least two professional artistic works in their chosen field to be considered for this award.

Application Questions:

COVER LETTER (500 word max)

A cover letter articulating your interest in the residency. Some questions to consider are:

- How can the residency benefit your current artistic practice?
- How can a partnership serve both yourself and the Tarragon Theatre community?
- What inspires you to work with Tarragon Theatre?
- What is your goal for a residency such as this?
- If transitioning disciplines, why now?

RESIDENCY PROPOSAL (750 word max)

Please share with us your residency proposal:

- A timeline (ie. A point form list of proposed activities to take place from January, 2026 January, 2027)
- A proposal regarding your interests/development goals and how you plan to achieve them with Tarragon's support

Please upload a CV/Resume detailing your training and artistic work
